ANMC thanks you for your service!

All veterans deserve quality health care, and as a veteran, you've earned your benefits. Veterans from all tours and eras are eligible to apply if you:

1. Completed your assigned active duty
2. Received an honorable discharge

Veterans in Alaska are now able to receive comprehensive medical services from their local Tribal health facility and do not have to travel to the Veteran's Administration (VA) Health Center nearest them. The VA wants all veterans to receive health care that improves their health and well-being.



Please let the front desk staff know if you have VA health benefits, so they can add it to your records.
