Out of Hospital Delivery

Guideline: Care of mother-baby couplet following an out of hospital delivery.

ADMISSION OF MOTHER/INFANT COUPLET DELIVERED OUTSIDE OF DELIVERY SUITE

Protocol:

- 1. When possible, a private room will be provided for the mother and infant.
- 2. The infant will room in with mother unless the infant's condition indicates that it needs a higher level of care. The infant may be allowed to enter the nursery at the discretion of the pediatrician on call utilizing all universal precautions.
- 3. Proceed with routine postpartum and newborn orders and the maternal admission database unless otherwise ordered.
- 4. Place hospital ID bands on mother and infant as soon as possible after delivery.
- 5. Record information in the Delivery Log within the electronic health record (EHR), noting "outside hospital delivery".
- 6. Proceed with rooming-in procedure and parent education.
