## Sterile vaginal exam

## Purpose:

- 1. Sterile vaginal examinations will be done by a qualified RN, CNM or MD to determine progress and status of labor as evidenced by dilation and effacement of cervix, station of presenting part and presentation of fetus.
- 2. Patients with vaginal bleeding, premature rupture of membranes, or premature labor are not examined vaginally without MD order.
- 3. To avoid unnecessary potential for infection vaginal exams are only done as warranted by patient's signs & symptoms of progress or provider order.

## Procedure:

- 1. Explain procedure to patient, screen for privacy, assist patient into appropriate position.
- 2. Maintain sterility of exam glove on hand of choice for exam. Apply sterile water-soluble lubricant to the index and middle finger.
- 3. Note cervical effacement, dilation, station as well as position.
- 4. Inform patient of findings and record in EHR.

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
