ANMC Dermatology eCONSULT (Teledermatology) Guidelines

MUST INCLUDE IN eCONSULT REQUEST (may copy and paste into order comments or documentation):

- **Statement that the patient gave informed consent to the provider placing consult request:**
The patient and I discussed the risks and benefits of referring them for a virtual telehealth consultation. Risks include potential breaches in privacy and lack of a physical exam. However, to expedite care and prevent delays, the patient and I agreed the benefits of a telemedicine consult outweigh the risks. The patient provided informed consent for a teledermatology consult.
- **Requester if different from provider:**
- **Requester's phone number:**
- **Requester's clinic fax number:**
- **Preferred method of receiving consult notes** (Cerner message center, fax)
- **Reason for consult** (Diagnosis)
- **Location on body**
- **History of present illness** (include duration & phases of progression of symptoms)
- **Treatments already tried and their outcomes**
- **Prior medical history** (examples: diabetes mellitus, hypertension, psoriasis, etc.)
- **Pertinent family history of skin disease**
- **Medication list** (include current, last three months, over the counter and other historical medications, if applicable)
- **Allergy list**

MULTIPLE IMAGES ARE NEEDED AND MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

1. Uploaded to Media Gallery
2. Ruler for scale (must be in cm or mm)
3. Focused close up view
4. Regional view with anatomic landmark
5. Side view for height and surface

Note/Tip: If paper tape measure unavailable, most 2x2 or 4x4 gauze sponges include a ruler on the packaging that you may use for scale.
