
## **ANMC C. difficile Testing Algorithm**



PCR Result	Toxin Assay Result	Interpretation	Recommendation
Negative	Not performed	No CDI Present	Evaluate for other causes of diarrhea
Positive	Positive	CDI Present	Start Treatment for <i>C. difficile</i> . Modified contact isolation precautions per ANMC Infection Control.
Positive	Negative	CDI Unlikely	Clinical infection may not be present; patient may be colonized with <i>C. difficile</i> in the gut. Treatment should be individualized; consider treatment with severe, non- resolving, or otherwise unexplained diarrhea strongly suggestive of CDI.

## CDI- C. difficile Infection; PCR- Polymerase Chain Reaction;

This does not replace clinical judgement, algorithm should be utilized as a guidance and can be overruled based on patient risk factors and physical exam.
